Dear Parents,

We have an exciting week ahead.

Next Tuesday is **Skipping Day**. This is part of healthy lifestyles education and all classes from Y1 to Y6 will have chance to work with East Riding Sports Development staff to develop skipping skills. There will also be a 2 minute time challenge, which will be repeated in 4-6 week's time to give children chance to practice what they have been taught and improve their individual performances. **ALL children will need P.E. kit.**
